

Five Block Degree Plan with UNC Charlotte Degree Requirements

Block 1 (23 course credits)

- Consists of certain prerequisite nursing courses that are (or will be) taken as a part of all North Carolina community college AAS nursing programs. The courses are:

| Human Anatomy and Physiology with lab | BIO 165&166 or 168 & 169 | KNES 2273 (4) and KNES 2274 (4) with labs |
| Humanities/Fine Arts | Select one from the following: ART 111, ART 114, ART 115, MUS 110, MUS 112, PHI 215, PHI 240, HUM 115 | Elective (3) |
| Psychology | PSY150, PSY 241 | PSYC 1100 (3) Elective (3) |

Block 2 (18-19 credits):

- Consists of additional university general education requirements that are not a part of an AAS degree but are required to earn a BSN.
- These general education requirements will be met by completing one listed course in each of the first four categories and two in the last.

| Fine Arts | <u>Select one additional course not taken in Block 1</u> from the following: ART 114, ART 115, MUS 110, MUS 112 | LBST 1100 (3) series |
| College Transfer Math | MAT 143 or MAT 171 | MAT elective (3) to count for MAT 1100 |
| Sociology | SOC 210 and one of the following: SOC 213, SOC 220, SOC 225 , SOC 230, SOC 240 | SOCY 1100 (3) LBST 2102 (3) (SOC 225 counts as LBST 2102) |

* If SOC 225 not selected then another course equivalent to LBST 2102 is required beyond the block.

Courses to select from include ANT 220, 221, GEO 111, 112, HIS 114, 115, 165 HUM 180, POL 210, 220 REL 110, 111

Block 3 (17-18 credits):

- Consists of additional nursing or other requirements that are not a part of an AAS degree but are required to earn a BSN. These courses are:

| Microbiology with lab | BIO 175 or 275 | BIOL 2259 (4) with lab |
| Chemistry with lab | CHM 151 or CHM 130 and CHM 130A or CHM 131 and 131A | CHEM 1203 (4) with lab |
| Social Science/ Elective: Select 2 from either category or one from each. | ECO 251, ECO 252, POL 120. Suggested electives include but are not limited to foreign language, speech, culture, and computer science. Electives must be selected from the Transfer Course List in the Comprehensive Articulation Agreement. | Electives Not required for degree. |

* If chose BIO 175 (3 credits) will need additional 1 credit elective in above category to meet degree requirements.

UNC Charlotte will award 39 credit hours for previous AAS nursing curriculum after successful completion (grade C or better) of NURN 3103 Concepts in Professional Nursing Science.
